## WEXFORD FESTIVAL OPERA GOES 'GREEN'



### Seven New EcoCerts Awarded. Nine More to Follow.

As part of a concerted effort to 'green' the Wexford Festival Opera, 15 Wexford businesses were given environmental certificates at an Awards ceremony at Wexford Opera House on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> October 2010.

This was the culmination of a unique project funded by the Environmental Protection Agency; project managed by the Wexford Festival Opera; and promoting the *Green Hospitality Award (GHA)* and *EcoCert* environmental certifications.

The project's aim was to recruit 16 hospitality businesses for GHA certification and 10 non-hospitality businesses for EcoCert. In fact, both targets were comfortably exceeded, with a total of 40 participating businesses.

### Tap Aerators & Flow Restrictors

### Toilet Cistern Retrofits

Watersave Ireland are now marketing a replacement siphon at around €42, which converts your conventional cistern to a dual flush cistern.
